Truman State University, in Kirksville with a bachelor's degree in accounting. Don is a Certified Public Accountant.

Don serves on the board of directors of the Clay County Economic Development Council. He is also a member of the Missouri Society of Certified Public Accountants, the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants and the Financial Executives International. Don is a past highway commissioner for Clay County.

Charitable involvement includes the National Multiple Sclerosis Society's annual MS Bike Ride. Don participates in the event's 150-mile bicycle ride in Kansas City and is recognized as one of the nation's top fund-raisers.
