KC Police Credit Union to Build New Branch at Northglen Village Location sits in the center of large population of credit union members

KANSAS CITY, Mo – Nov. 16, 2009 – Hunt Midwest Real Estate Development, Inc. announces that K.C. Police Credit Union (KCPCU) has completed the purchase of a 1.4 acre tract in Northglen Village, on the northwest corner of Missouri Highway 152 and North Brighton in Kansas City.

KCPCU will construct a new Northland branch building on the site to replace the existing branch in the nearby Northglen Shopping Center. "We selected the site at 152 and N. Brighton because of ease of access and visibility from M-152, and because geographically, it sits right in the center of a large population of our credit union members," said Aaron Goff, president and CEO of Kansas City Police Credit Union.

Construction will begin after the first of the year and the branch is expected to be open for business in late 2010. The new branch will feature drive-through lanes and a drive-through ATM.

"KC Police Credit Union's new building will be prominently situated in the fastest growing corridor in the Northland, with more than 37,000 cars passing the site each day," said Dick Ringer, assistant general manager of Hunt Midwest. "This location will provide convenient access to KCPCU members living and working in the area." Founded in 1934 as the K.C. Policemen's Credit Union, KCPCU opened its Northland branch in 2006. The credit union's main branch is located in downtown Kansas City. A third branch is located within the Kansas City, Missouri Police Department headquarters.

About Northglen Village

Northglen Village is a 28-acre retail project developed by Hunt Midwest along Missouri Highway 152 and North Brighton in Kansas City near the full-diamond exchange of MO Highway 152 and I-435. The development, which provides an ideal location for commercial and retail development, is anchored by a 14-screen movie theater and includes restaurants, fire station and post office annex. A 2.2-acre lot is currently available for commercial development.
