Construction Begins on North Oak Village Retail Center

KANSAS CITY, MO – August 8, 2007 – North Oak Village Developers, the R.H. Johnson Company and Hunt Midwest, announced today that construction on the 30-acre retail shopping area at North Oak Trafficway and Vivion Road in Kansas City, Mo., will begin the second week of August, commencing with site and primary utility work.

In addition, the developers announced that the anchor tenants of the project will be a 138,000 s.f. Lowe's home improvement center, along with a 20,000 s.f. Office Depot store. In addition to Lowe's and Office Depot, the center will offer seven retail pad sites. Currently, negotiations are ongoing for five of the seven sites. The leasing agent for the regional pad sites is Chuck Zoog of the R.H. Johnson Company. Announcements of these facilities will be forthcoming when the leases are signed.
